Haylor receives grant from William E. Simon Olympic Endowment

INDIANAPOLIS – Alyson Haylor, a member of the 2012 USA Synchro Junior National Training Squad, recently received a \$3,000 grant from the William E. Simon Olympic Endowment.

Haylor (Walnut Creek, Calif./Walnut Creek Aquanuts) finished second with Marisa Tashima in junior duet and fourth in senior solo at the 2011 U.S. Open Synchronized Swimming Championships. She was also a member of the 2010 Junior National Team.

The William E. Simon Olympic Endowment for the Support of Athletes was established in 1998 by William E. Simon Sr., former U.S. Olympic Committee President and U.S. Secretary of the Treasury. The grants are intended for training and competition expenses.

The 2012 USA Synchro Junior National Training Squad will be cut to 12 swimmers in May to form the 2012 USA Synchro Junior National Team, which will compete in the 13th World Junior Synchronized Swimming Championships in Greece in September.
